

Recycle Week Online Game Prize Draw 18 September 2017 – 13 October 2017

Terms and Conditions

1. The free prize draw is run by North London Waste Authority (“NLWA” or “the Promoter”), through its Wise Up To Waste (WUTW) brand. The prize draw is free to enter and no payment is required.
2. To be eligible for the free prize draw, entrants must be a resident of Great Britain in the north London Boroughs of Barnet, Camden, Enfield, Hackney, Haringey, Islington and Waltham Forest (the Boroughs) and must be over the age of 18. Employees of NLWA or its affiliates or any third party directly associated with the administration of the prize draw are not eligible to enter. Failure to comply with any part of these terms and conditions will disqualify the respective entry from the prize draw.
3. The opening date for entries is 8am on 18 September 2017 and the closing date is 12 noon on 13 October 2017 (UK time) (“Entry Period”). Entries received after this time will not be valid.
4. The prize draw will be held after the closing date and only one entry per person will be accepted during the Entry Period.
5. To enter the free prize draw, eligible entrants must complete the online recycling game available at <http://wiseuptowaste.org.uk/recycle/what-can-i-recycle-at-home/waste-or-recycling-game>, complete the form on the website with their contact details and submit the completed form online during the Entry Period. Entrants need to have gained full marks for the online recycling game in order to enter the prize draw. No payment is required. Upon submission of the online form, entrants will be automatically entered into the prize draw. Entries not meeting the criteria set out in these conditions will not be valid and will not be entered into the prize draw.
6. One winner will be selected, at random, at the end of the Entry Period. Only one entry per person will be accepted. The winner will receive a simplehuman dual waste and recycling kitchen bin (The “Prize”). There is one prize available only.
7. NLWA shall contact the winner by email after 13 October 2017. The winner must provide valid proof of address (i.e. a digital copy of their Council Tax bill or Driving licence), to show that they are a resident of one of the Boroughs in order to claim their Prize. If the winner does not respond to NLWA by the end of 23 October 2017, then the winner’s Prize will be forfeited.

8. The winner will be given the option of either having the Prize delivered to any address in one of the Boroughs, or collecting the prize from NLWA's offices at Unit 1B Berol House, 25 Ashley Road, Tottenham Hale, London, N17 9LJ. If the winner has opted for the prize to be delivered to a north London address, the Prize will be delivered to the winner before 15 November 2017. If the winner has opted to collect the Prize from NLWA's offices, the Prize must be collected before 30 November 2017. If the winner does not collect the Prize before this date, NLWA reserves the right to forfeit the winner's Prize.
9. Obscene or inappropriate entries as determined by NLWA at its sole discretion will not be accepted and NLWA reserves the right to reject any entries for any reason at its sole discretion.
10. NLWA takes no responsibility for any entries which are lost, delayed, illegible, corrupted, damaged, incomplete or otherwise invalid. NLWA accepts no responsibility for entries not successfully completed due to a technical fault including but not limited to technical malfunction, computer hardware or software failure, satellite, network or server failure of any kind **OR** If for any reason a technical interruption, fault or site failure occurs when completing the online form, NLWA does not take any responsibility for the incomplete form and any incomplete form will not be considered valid for entry into the prize draw.
11. To the extent permitted by applicable law, NLWA's liability under or in connection with the prize draw or these terms and conditions shall be limited to the value of the Prize in question.
12. To the extent permitted by applicable law, NLWA shall not be liable under or in connection with these terms and conditions, the prize draw or any prize for any indirect, special or consequential cost, expense, loss or damage suffered by a participant even if such cost, expense, loss or damage was reasonably foreseeable or might reasonably have been contemplated by the participant and/or the Promoter and whether arising from breach of contract, tort, negligence, breach of statutory duty or otherwise.
13. Entrants will be given the option of opting into receiving further relevant information from NLWA in the future. Personal data obtained by NLWA from entrants will be processed in accordance with the DATA PROTECTION ACT 1998.
14. The Prize is non-negotiable, non-transferable, and non-refundable and no cash alternative is offered. Where the Prize becomes unavailable for any reason, NLWA reserves the right to substitute that Prize for a Prize of equal or higher value.

15. In the event of unforeseen circumstances beyond NLWA's reasonable control, NLWA reserves the right to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the free prize draw or these terms and conditions, either in whole or in part, with or without notice.
16. NLWA's decision is final and binding. No correspondence will be entered into.
17. Copyright and all intellectual property rights in all entries shall be owned by NLWA.
18. Entrants are deemed to have accepted and agreed to be bound by these terms and conditions upon entry. By submitting an entry to the prize draw, entrants are deemed to have granted their consent to publicity, in the form of an NLWA press release, related to the free prize draw in the manner provided in these terms and conditions in the event that they are selected as the winner of a prize draw.
19. These terms and conditions and the prize draw are governed by English law and entrants to the prize draw submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the English courts.
